The Northbridge Sailing Club Training Boat Project

As many members know and have experienced, the training program run by the club is the source of the continuing membership and life of the club. The Program is one of the best in the state being copied by other similar clubs to maintain the continuity of membership and introduce as many people as possible to the world of sailing.

Traditionally our club has relied on the membership fees to purchase new equipment for training. This year the club has received approval from the Australian Sports Foundation (ASF) to seek tax deductible donations for an equipment fund. Our target is \$39,000 to be raised over 2 years.

How does it work?

The Australian Sports Foundation (ASF) was established by the Australian Government to assist organisations in raising funds for the development of sport. In order for donations to be tax deductible, they must be made unconditionally to the ASF, however their structure allows donors to nominate a registered project as the preferred beneficiary of their gift. 'NSC Training Boat Project' Number 208445 is a registered ASF project.

Donations can be made by cash, cheque (made payable to ASF) or credit card, a receipt will be issued by the ASF to substantiate taxation claims. Payment and the attached completed ASF Donation Form are forwarded to the Clubs Treasurer, who then submits all documents to the ASF for processing.
